

CEFE Employability

In Brief

Entrepreneurship can be trained, but not necessarily has to. The CEFE Employability training covers the 80% of people who are not willing to take the risk of starting their own business. The training targets jobseekers in general and graduates of secondary or technical vocational schools and higher education in particular. It serves as a powerful tool to combat youth unemployment. Jointly (max.) 25 participants prepare themselves for discovering job opportunities and presenting their qualification to potential employers. But before even going deep into application training, they need to stimulate their life skills: creativity, motivation, persistence commitment.

CEFE Employability can be part of a systemic sequence of modules where participants firstly check their own preferences and then decide how to continue on their gateway to a better future: further education, employability or business creation.

Deliverables

At the end of the training the participants see, understand and explore opportunities on the labour market.

Training Deliverables

- Life Skills Training (1-2 days)
- Labour Market Understanding (1/2 day)
- Road Map Definition (1/2 day)
- Job Application Training (1 day)

Instruments

Participant centred learning, basic CEFE exercises modularized for this specific target group; peer learning, if possible in contact with socially engaged entrepreneurs.



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Duration of Service

Training of target group 3 to 5 days.
Coaching in job application can be complemented.

Upgrading workshop for CEFE trainers 3 days plus coaching session
