Migration Tools – Options for Sustainability

In Brief

Most migrants reap gains in the form of better opportunities, higher incomes, better access to education and health, and improved prospects for their children. Many of them don't want to re-migrate but care for supporting their social networks at home. In many countries remittances from migrants exceed by far the value of official development assistance. Rooted in their home countries and exposed to experiences abroad migrants can become drivers for local economic development in many ways.

On behalf of GIZ, CEFE International has developed MITOS as a tool box for successful valorisation of migrants in a wide range of opportunities: target-oriented websites, challenge funds, idea generation, business mentoring, foreign trade linkages, B2B cooperation, venture finance...

CEFE MITOS can become part of a larger programme, e.g. Local and Regional Economic Development, or simply provide the assistance necessary to use one of the MITOS tools.

Deliverables

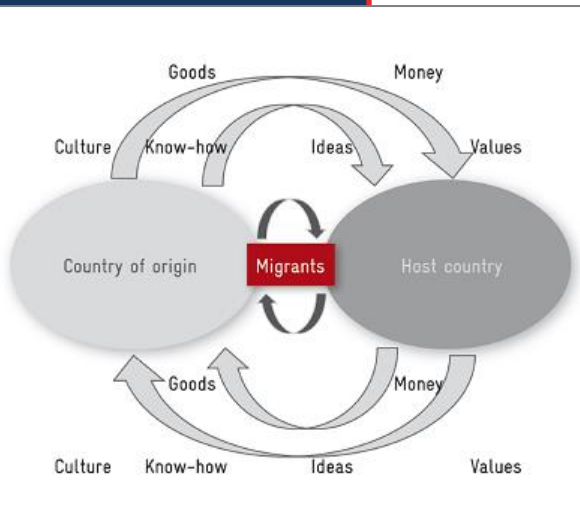
Depending on the client's request MITOS will deliver:
